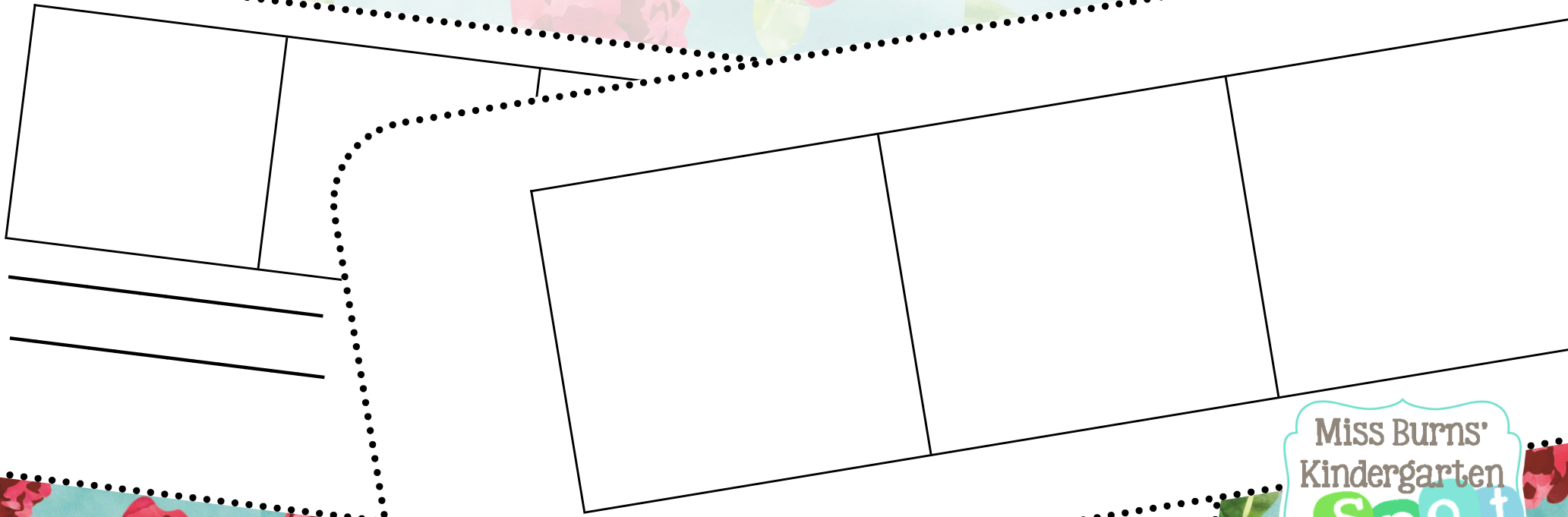


# Elkonin Sound Boxes

# How can I use this?

- Use during guided reading, word work, or writing time to help your students segment phonemes
- Give your students the same number of chips as there are boxes.
- Have them put the chips at the bottom of each box. To help with this, I tell my students to put the wheels on the bus.
- Then, give them a word to segment. For each sound or phoneme, they push the chip into the box. You can start by modeling the process and steps or they can jump in depending on their familiarity.
- As an extension, have your students write the letters for each sound on the lines below the boxes or right inside of the boxes.



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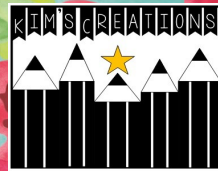
